
Yarn from www.favoritgarner.com – "Swedish Christmas" is available as yarn kits in many different colour combinations. Each kit contains 17 balls of Soft Fun (incl Aquarel and/or Denim). To get information about how to order a kit, please send an e-mail to **info@favoritgarner.se**

Crochet hook: 4,0 mm **Size cushion**: 65 x 65 cm (cushion not included in the yarn kit)

Limnell Designs square Sirius is made with the colour pack "12 – Limnell Design" (Colours 5x2412, 4x2492, 4x806, 4x502).

The original cushion is made in the colour pack "01 – Swedish Christmas" (Colours 5 x 2412, 4 x 2410, 4 x 806 och 4 x 2532).

IMPORTANT INFORMATION: The square with a last row in colour white has the measurement 20 x 20 cm. When you make the square for the cushion "Swedish Christmas" you need to add a row in colour 502 (or other colour, same colour on all squares). It should then be 20,5 x 20,5 cm. If your square end up smaller, you can probably block it to the correct size, but if you get a larger square, you need to use a smaller size crochet hook.

Chain= ch

Stitch = st

Slip stitch = slst

Single crochet = sc

Frontpost single crochet = fpsc

Half double crochet = hdc

Double crochet = dc

Treble crochet = tr

Frontpost double crochet = fpdc

Backpost double crochet = bpdc

Frontpost treble = fptr

Popcorn: 4 double crochet and close with a chain. The ch doesn't count as a stitch

Skip = sk

Chain space = ch sp

Three frontpost double crochets together = fpdc3tog

Three trebles together = tr3tog

Två reliefdubbelstolpar tillsammans = fptr2tog

Repeat whats in (...) the number of times stated after the parenthesis or to the part mentioned. If the pattern doesn't say anything else, every row is closed with an "invisible join" (needle join). There are instruction videos on Youtube if you haven't tried this before.

Start with a magic ring.

Round:

- 1. (806) Ch 2 (1:st dc), 15 dc. (16 dc)
- 2. (2492) This round is made in the back loop only. Start in any st with a ch 1 (1:st sc), (2 sc in the same st, 1sc in the next st) repeat all the way around. (24 sc)









3. (806) Start in the back loop of the 1:st sc in an increase with a ch 1 (1:st sc), (1 dc in the front loop of the stitch to the left of the one straight below on row 1, 3 sc in the back loop, 1 dc in the same front loop as before, 3 sc in the back loop)*4 (In the last repeat there is only 2 sc in the end.) (8 dc, 24 sc)



4. (2492) Start in the back loop of a sc directly to the left of a dc in a "v" with a ch 1 (1st sc), 2 sc in the back loop, (7 dc in the front loop in the sc on row 2 visible in the middle of a "v", sk 5 st, 3 sc in the back loop)*4 (In the last repeat, the 7 dc:s will be the last stitches) (28 dc, 12 sc)









5. (806) Start in the back loop in the 1:st of 3 sc with a ch 1 (1:st sc), 2 sc in the back loop, (1fpdc around the dc below on row 3, 7 sc in the back loop, 1 fpdc around the dc below on row 3, 3 sc in the back loop)*4 (In the last repeat the fpdc will be tha last st) (8 fpdc, 40 sc)



6. (2492) Start in the back loop of the 1:st of 3 sc with a ch 1 (1:st sc), (3 sc in the back loop of the same sc, 2 sc in the back loop, 1 fpdc2tog around the first 2 dc below on row 4, 1 fpdc around the next 3 dc on row 4, 1 fpdc2tog around the last 2, sk 7 sc, 2 fsc in the back loop)*4 (In the last repeat there is only 1 sc in the end) (8 fpdc2tog, 12 fpdc, 28 sc)









7. (806) Start in the back loop in the 1:st sc in an increase with a ch 1 (1:st sc), (3 sc in the back loop in the same sc, 4 sc in the back loop, 1 fptr around the fpdc below on row 5, 3 sc in the back loop, 1 fptr around the fpdc below on row 5, 4 sc in the back loop)*4 (In the last repeat, there is only 3 sc in the end) (8 fptr, 56 sc)









8. (2492) Start in the back loop in the 1:st sc in an increase with a ch 1 (1:st sc), (3 sc in the back loop of the same sc, 6 sc in the back loop, 1 fpdc2tog around the fpdc2tog and the 1:st fpdc below on row 6, 1 fpdc around the fpdc below on row 6, 1 fpdc2tog around the next fpdc and the fpdc2tog below on row 6, sk 3 sc, 6 sc in the back loop)*4 (In the last repeat, there is only 5 sc in the end) (4 fpdc, 8 fpdc2tog, 60 sc)



9. (806) Start in the back loop in the 1:st sc in an increase with a ch 1 (1:st sc), (3 sc in the back loop of the same sc, 7 sc in the back loop, 1 fpdc around the fptr below on row 7, 3 sc in the back loop, 1 fpdc around the fptr below on row 7, 7 sc in the back loop)*4 (In the last repeat, there is only 6 sc in the end) (8 fpdc, 80 sc)









10. (2492) Start in the back loop in the 1:st sc in an increase with a ch 1 (1:st sc), (3 sc in the back loop of the same sc, 10 sc in the back loop, 1 fpdc3tog around the 2 fpdc2tog and the fpdc between them below on row 8, sk 1 sc, 10 sc in the back loop)*4 (In the last repeat, there is only 9 sc in the end) (4 rfst3tills, 92 fm)



11. (806) Start in the back loop in the 1:st sc in an increase with a ch 1 (1:st sc), (3 sc in the back loop of the same sc, 11 sc in the back loop, 1 fptr2tog around the 2 fpdc below on row 9, sk 1 fpdc3tog, 11 sc in the back loop)*4 (In the last repeat, there is only 10 sc in the end) (4 fpdc2tog, 100 sc)

12. (2412) Start in a corner with a ch 1 (1:st sc)

Corner: 3 sc in the middle of the 3sc:s from previous row.

Side: 1 sc in the back loop of every st. (27 fsc/side, 1 sc in every corner)

13. (502) Start in a corner with a ch 1 (1:st sc)Corner: 3 sc in the middle of the 3sc:s from previous row. Side: 4 sc in the back loop, (1 dc in the front loop in a sc below on row 11, sk 1 sc, 2 sc in the back loop)*3, 1 fptr around the fptr2tog below on row 11, (2 sc in the back loop, 1 dc in the front loop in a sc below on row 11, sk 1 sc)*3, 4 sc. ((6 dc, 1 fptr, 22 sc)/side, 1 sc in every corner)



14. (2492) Now turn the square with the wrong side facing you. Start in a corner with a ch 1 (1:st sc) Hörn: 3 sc in the middle of the 3sc:s from previous row.

Side: Crochet in the loop closest to you when making the sc:s and thorugh both loops when making the bobbles. Crochet 1 sc in every sc and 1 bobble in every dc and fptr. The bobbles are made of 5 dc:s together.

((7 bobbles, 24 sc)/side, 1 sc in every corner)



15. (592) Now turn your square with the right side facing you again and all the stitches are made in the back loop. Start in any stitch with a ch 1 (1:st sc) Corner: 3 sc in the middle of the 3sc:s from previous row.

Side: 1 sc in every stitch. (33 sc/side, 1 sc in every corner)

16. (2412) Start in any stitch with a ch 1 (1:st sc) Corner: 1 sc, ch 2, 1 sc, Side: 1 sc in the back loop of every stitch. (35 fsc/side, ch 2 in every corner)







17. (502) (if you do the cushion "Swedish Christmas" you need to add this row): 1 sc in each st, in the corners 3 sc.

Instructions for blocking will be posted day 19. Correct size after blocking should be 20,5 cm.





Square 2 is done, to be continued... The pattern contains 24 parts. *********
