Yarn from www.favoritgarner.com – "Swedish Christmas" is available as yarn kits in many different colour combinations. Each kit contains 17 balls of Soft Fun (incl Aquarel and/or Denim). To get information about how to order a kit, please send an e-mail to **info@favoritgarner.se**

Crochet hook: 4,0 mm **Size cushion**: 65 x 65 cm (cushion not included in the yarn kit)

From Moström With Loves square **Candy Lane** is made with colour pack "22 – From Moström With Love" (5 x 2412, 4 x 803, 4 x 503 och 4 x 2495)

The original cushion is made in the colour pack "01 – Swedish Christmas" (5 x 2412, 4 x 2410, 4 x 806 och 4 x 2532)

IMPORTANT INFORMATION: The square with a last row in colour white has the measurement 20×20 cm. When you make the square for the cushion "Swedish Christmas" you need to add a row in colour 502 (or other colour for the colour pack you will use) on all squares. It should then be 20.5×20.5 cm. If your square end up smaller, you can probably block it to the correct size, but if you get a larger square, you need to use a smaller size crochet hook.

Colors:

1 - 2412

2 - 803

3 - 503.

4 - 2495

Stitches and abbriviations:

ch – chain stitch
ch sp – chain space
sl st – slip stich
sc – single crochet
hdc – half double crochet
dc – double crochet

htr - half treble crochet

tr - treble crochet

Puff – Yarn over, insert the hook into the specified stitch. Pull the yarn through the stitch. *Yarn over and insert the hook into the same stitch and yo again. Pull the yarn through the stitch* 3 more times. You should now have 9 loops on your hook. Yarn over and pull the yarn through all your loops.

FPdc - Front post double crochet

BPdc - Back post double crochet

BPdc2tog - Back post double crochet 2 together (BPdc2tog) - Yarn over, insert your hook from the back around the specified stitch, from right to left, yarn over, yarn over and pull through, yarn over and pull through two loops. Yarn over and insert your hook from the back around the next specified stitch, yarn over and pull through, yarn over and pull through the last three loops on your hook.

..... x times – work the instructions between *.....* the total number of times stated. Some rows are made from the wrong side.

You can start each row with a standing sc or dc, but also with ch 1 or ch 2 as the first st.







PATTERN

Ch 4 and sl st in first ch to form a ring, or use a magic ring to begin row 1.

Row 1 (color 1): Ch 2 and 11 dc in ring.



Row 2 (color 4): Ch 2 + 1 puff. Ch 1. *1 dc + 1 puff in next st. Ch 1* 11 times. SI st in second ch. Cut and fasten yarn.



Row 3 (color 3): Ch 1+1 sc in same st. 1 sc in next 35 st. Skip ch 1 and sl st i first sc.

Row 4: Ch 1+1sc i same st. *Ch 2, skip 2 st, 1 sc in next st* 11 times Ch 4. Skip 2 st and ch 1. Cut and fasten yarn.






Row 5 contains of 11 cable loops and 1 cable cord, that on row 6 forms a cable in 2 colors. You can make the cable loops in 1 color.

Row 5 (color 1 and 2): 1 standing sc + 1 sc in ch-4 space. Ch 11. Turn and make 1 sc in first sc. Turn and make 17 sc in ring. 2 sc in same ch-4 space. Cut and fasten yarn.

Change color. Sl st in sc and make 2 sc in next ch-4 space. Ch 11. Turn and make 1 sc in first sc. Turn and make 17 sc in ring. 2 sc in same ch-4 space. Cut and fasten yarn. 10 times Change color. Sl st in sc and make 2 sc in next ch-4 space. Make the cable cord by making ch 12 and make 16 sc around ch-12 space. 2 sc same ch-4 space. Sl st in first st from beginning of row.















Row 6: Pull the second cable loop through first cord loop. Pull the the third loop through the second and continue until the cable cord. Pull the cable cord through the 11th cable loop, under the first cable loop and down through the 11th cable loop. Cut and fasten yarn.















Row 7 (color 4): Turn your work. 1 standing sc in sc between ch-4 space in row 4. *Ch 5, skip ch-4 space, 1 sc in next sc in row 4* 11 times. SI st i standing sc from beginning of row.



Row 8: Turn your work. Ch 2+3 dc in ch space. 4 dc in each ch space. In total 48 st.

Row 9: Ch 2. 1 dc in next 2 st. 2 dc in next st. *1 dc in next 3 st. 2 st in next st* Repeat across row. SI st in ch 2. Cut and fasten yarn.

Total 60 st.



Row 10 (color 3): 1 standing sc in any st. 1 sc in next st. 1 hdc in next 2 st. 1 dc in next 2 st. 1 htr in next st. *2 tr+ch 3+2 tr in next st. 1 htr in next st. 1 dc in next 2 st. 1 hdc in next 2 st. 1 sc in next 4 st. 1 hdc in next 2 st. 1 dc in next 2 st. 1 htr i next st* 3 times. 2 tr+ch 3+2 tr in next st. 1 htr i next st. 1 dc in next 2 st. 1 hdc in next 2 st. 1 sc in next 2 st. Sl st in standing sc from beginning of row. Cut and fasten yarn.







Varv 11 (color 2): 1 standing dc, 1 dc+ch 3+ 2 dc in any ch-3 space.

1 dc in next 18 st. 2 dc+ch 3+2 dc in ch-3 space 3 times

1 dc in next 18 st. SI st in standing dc from beginning of row. Cut and fasten yarn.



Row 12 Turn your work. 1 standing dc, 1 dc+ch 3+2 dc in any ch-3 space.

1 FPdc in next 22 st. 2 dc+ch 3+2 dc in ch-3 space 3 times.

1 FPdc in next 22 st. SI st in first standing dc from beginning of row. Cut and fasten yarn.

Varv 13 (color 2): Turn your work. 1 standing dc+ch 3+1 dc in any ch-3 space.

1 BPdc in next 26 st. 1 dc+ch 3+1 dc in ch-3 space 3 times.

1 BPdc in next 26 st. SI st in first standing dc from beginning of row. Cut and fasten yarn.

Row 14 (color 1): Turn work and work from the wrong side. 1 standing dc, 1 dc+ch 3+2 dc in any ch-3 space.

1 FPdc in next 28 st. 2 dc+ch 3+2 dc in ch-3 space 3 times

1 FPdc in next 28 st. SI st i standing dc from beginning of row. Cut and fasten yarn.

Row 15 (color 2): Turn work. 1 standing dc, 1 dc+ch 3+2 dc in any ch-3 space.

1 BPdc in next 15 st. BPdc2tog i next 2 st. 1 BPdc in next 15 st. 2 dc+ch 3+2 dc in ch-3 space 3 times.

1 BPdc in next 15 st. BPdc2tog i next 2 st. 1 BPdc in next 15 st. SI st in standing dc from beginning of row. Cut and fasten yarn.

Row 16 (color 1): 1 standing sc+2 sc in any corner. *1 sc in back loop only in next 35 st. 3 sc in ch-3 space* 3 times. 1 sc in back loop only in next 35 st. Sl st in standing sc from beginning of row. Cut och fasten yarn

Make a stitch in each of the cable loops to make sure they are attached to the square.

The square is done after R 19, BUT if you do the cushion "Swedish Christmas" you need to add another edging round in another colour.

Row 17 (color 4): 1 sc in each st, in the corners 3 sc.
